

DAY 1: THURSDAY 7th MAY

- Depart Detroit International Airport on a regularly scheduled overnight TransAtlantic flight to Frankfurt Rhein-Main International Airport

DAY 2: FRIDAY 8th MAY, 2015

- Arrive in **Germany** where our full time bilingual Quest Sports Travel Tour Manager meets the group to travel by private motor coach to the nearby town of **Heidelberg**
- **Check in** to accommodation for a 4 night stay in triple bedded rooms (twin for staff)
- Settle in to the hotel then transfer to local fields for **practice** with the Wolverines' staff
- Dinner at the hotel after the game

DAY 3: SATURDAY 9th MAY, 2015

- Breakfast at the hotel then travel enjoy a **guided tour of Heidelberg** - Summertime in Heidelberg, according to the song from *The Student Prince*, is a time for music and romance. One of the few cities undamaged by either war, Heidelberg retains its Middle Ages and early Renaissance charm and character. Conclude the tour by taking the funicular to **Schloss Heidelberg** - the partly ruined, red-sandstone Schloß is one of Germany's finest Gothic-Renaissance fortresses
- Lunch on your own then transfer to attend a **professional game** from the **German Bundesliga** (ticket included, game depending on schedule)
- Return to the hotel for dinner this evening




Exhibit at the futuristic Porsche Museum

DAY 4: SUNDAY 10th MAY, 2015

- After breakfast return to **Frankfurt** for a **guided tour** of the city - Germany's fifth-largest city has its most spectacular skyline, mirrored in the Main River, including Europe's tallest office building. It is also home to a wonderful *Altstadt* (Old Town), that was once one of Europe's greatest, including Goethe's birthplace, the 13th century Cathedral, and the Römer, an interconnected trio of medieval patrician's houses, that were used as the City Hall as early as 1405
- Later, transfer to the **first friendly game** of the tour against a local team.
- Return to the hotel for dinner after the game

DAY 5: MONDAY 11th MAY, 2015

- Breakfast at the hotel then return to the training facility for morning **practice** with the Wolverines' staff
- After practice travel south to **Stuttgart** to visit the *Porsche Museum* - On exhibit are such prizes as the first Porsche-branded car, the Formula 1 champions of the mid-1980s and exhibits of how fenders, engines, and dashboards come together to make the 911s or Boxsters
- Free time to explore **Stuttgart** - Stuttgart manages to master the blend of technological innovation and green initiatives protecting and enhancing the environment - two-thirds of the land inside city limits is devoted to parks, gardens, and woodland
- Return to Heidelberg for dinner at the hotel

DAY 6: TUESDAY 12th MAY, 2015

- Check out after breakfast and head south towards the **Allgau** area of the Bavarian Alps
- Head to the Alpine village of **Immenstadt** and take a chair lift to the Alpine hut “Bärenfalle”
- Lunch on your own and time to take in the breathtaking views then take the exhilarating **Alpsee coaster** to the base of the mountain
- Later, **check in** to a local hotel and enjoy a traditional Bavarian dinner

DAY 8: THURSDAY 14th MAY, 2015

- After breakfast check out and travel to visit Fussen and then the nearby remarkable Neuschwanstein Castle - one of two Royal Castles in the area, Neuschwanstein was the brainchild the aptly named "Mad" King Ludwig
- Continue to **Munich** and **check in** to an area hotel for a 4 night stay
- Pre-game meal at the hotel then transfer to the **third friendly game** of the tour against a local club team
- Return to the hotel after the game

DAY 7: WEDNESDAY 13th MAY, 2015

- After breakfast cross the nearby **Austrian** border to visit **Bregenz**
- Just minutes from the German and Swiss borders, the beauty of Bregenz is its ability to travel in space and time; it's a place where you can wake up to breakfast on the beach at Bodensee and within minutes survey the Austrian Alps from the 1064m-high Pfänder; roam the twisting cobblestone streets of the Oberstadt (upper town) then hit the crystalline waterfront for an avant-garde art fix; pedal through orchards hugging the shore and sample homegrown flavors in a boho cafe.
- This afternoon continue into **Switzerland** for the **second friendly game** of the tour against a local club team, including a post-match dinner and social event with the opposing team and coaches

DAY 9: FRIDAY 15th MAY, 2015

- Breakfast at the hotel then transfer to the amazing **Allianz Arena**, home of German and European Champions Bayern Munich, for a **guided tour** of the Stadium
- Complete the tour at their training facilities for a “Behind the Scenes” look at a top level professional training session
- Later, head to central **Munich** and meet a local guide for a **guided tour** of the city - take in all the major sites, including the Altstadt that is known for its grand avenues and squares that recall the glory of the monarchy and *Schlöss Nymphenburg*, the country house of the Wittelsbach's, Munich's rulers for centuries
- Dinner at the hotel this evening

DAY 10: SATURDAY 16th MAY, 2015

- After breakfast transfer to the **fourth friendly game** of the tour against a local team
- After the game attend a **professional game** from the **German Bundesliga** (ticket included, game depending on schedule)
- Farewell dinner at a pre-selected restaurant



DAY 11: SUNDAY 17th MAY, 2015

- Breakfast at the hotel then depart for **Dachau**, a vivid reminder of Nazi atrocities during the Second World War. In 1933, what had once been a quiet little artists' community became a tragic symbol of the Nazi era as Himmler and the SS set up the first German concentration camp on the grounds of a former ammunition factory here. During its notorious history, more than 206,000 prisoners from 30 countries were imprisoned at Dachau, perhaps a lot more
- Return to downtown **Munich** for a free afternoon to complete your sightseeing - Pulsing with prosperity and Gemütlichkeit (cosiness), Munich revels in its own contradictions. Folklore and age-old traditions exist side by side with sleek BMWs, designer boutiques and high-powered industry
- Farewell dinner at a pre-selected restaurant
