Day 1: Friday 12th February, 2016

- Depart Newark Liberty International Airport at 7:20 p.m. on United Airlines flight #960 to Frankfurt Rhein Main International Airport

Day 2: Saturday 13th February, 2016

- Arrive in **Frankfurt** at 9:15 a.m. where our full time Quest Sports Travel Tour Manager meets the group to travel by private motor coach to the city center
- enjoy a **guided walking tour** of **Frankfurt** - Germany's fifth-largest city has it's most spectacular skyline, mirrored in the Main River, including Europe's tallest office building. It is also home to a wonderful Altstadt (Old Town), that was once one of Europe's greatest, including Goethe's birthplace, the 13th century Cathedral, and the Römer, an interconnected trio of medieval patrician's houses, that were used as the City Hall as early as 1405
- This afternoon travel south to **Heidelberg** and **check in** to an area hotel for a 3 night stay in triple bedded rooms
- Dinner at the hotel this evening

Note - there may be an opportunity to watch a Bundesliga game this afternoon with games scheduled at Darmstadt and Schalke (ticket not included, game depending on tv flex schedule and availability)

Day 3: Sunday 14th February, 2016

- Breakfast at the hotel then enjoy a **guided walking tour** of **Heidelberg** - One of the few cities undamaged by either war, Heidelberg retains its Middle Ages and early Renaissance charm and character. Conclude the tour by taking the funicular to Schloß Heidelberg - the partly ruined, red-sandstone Schloß is one of Germany's finest Gothic-Renaissance fortresses
- This afternoon return to the training fields for **practice** with a *professional German clinician* licensed by the *Deutsche Fussball Bund (DFB)*
- Return to the hotel for dinner after practice

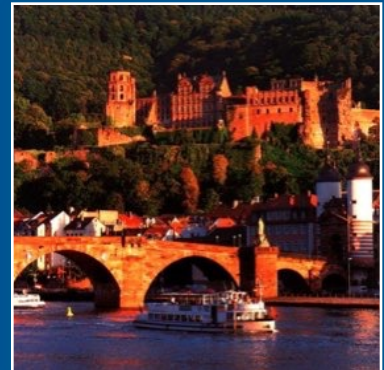
Day 4: Monday 15th February, 2016

- After breakfast return to **Frankfurt** to tour the **Commerzbank Arena**, home to local favorites *Eintracht Frankfurt* and a 2006 World Cup Semi-Final
- Free time to further explore Frankfurt then transfer this afternoon to the tour's **first friendly game** against a top local club team (e.g. **FFF Frankfurt**) including a post game social event and dinner with the opposing team
- Return to the hotel after the game

Day 5: Tuesday 16th February, 2016

- Check out after breakfast and travel east en route to **Nuremberg** - During the 15th and 16th centuries, Nürnberg enjoyed a cultural flowering that made it into the center of the German Renaissance, a northern Florence
- Arrive in Nuremberg and **check in** to a local hotel for a 2 night stay
- Settle in to the hotel then depart for local fields for **practice** with the PDA staff
- Return to the hotel for dinner this evening

- After breakfast transfer to the facilities of *Bundesliga II* club **1. FC Nürnberg** for a *behind the scenes* look at the daily training of a professional club
- This afternoon transfer to the **second friendly game** of the tour against a top local club
- Return to the hotel for dinner this evening

Day 7: Thursday 18th February, 2016

- After breakfast check out and travel south towards the Bavarian capital, **Munich**
- Arrive in **Munich** and meet a local guide for a **guided tour** of the city - take in all the major sites, including the Altstadt that is known for its grand avenues and squares that recall the glory of the monarchy and Schloß Nymphenburg, the country house of the Wittelsbach's, Munich's rulers for centuries
- Later, **check in** to a Munich area hotel for a 3 night stay
- Dinner at the hotel this evening



Day 8: Friday 19th February, 2016

- Breakfast at the hotel then depart for local fields for **practice** with a *professional German clinician* licensed by the *Deutsche Fussball Bund (DFB)*
- This afternoon transfer to the **Allianz Arena**, home of *Bayern Munich*, for a guided tour of the Stadium and Museum
- Conclude the tour at the training facilities of German and European giants Bayern Munich for a "*Behind the Scenes*" look at a top level professional training session
- Return to the hotel for dinner this evening

Day 10: Saturday 20th February, 2016

- After breakfast transfer to **third friendly game** of the tour against top local club
- After the game depart to attend a **professional game** from the **German Bundesliga**. Today's games include newcomers **FC Ingolstadt 04** vs. **SV Werder Bremen** (ticket included, game depending on tv flex schedule and availability)
- Farewell dinner at a pre-selected restaurant after the game

Day 10: Sunday 21st February, 2016

- Check out after breakfast and take the short journey to Munich Franz Josef Strauss International Airport for the return flight to the United States
- Depart Munich at 9:20 a.m. on United Airlines flight #107 to Newark Liberty International Airport, arriving in Newark at 12:50 p.m.
