Day 1: Friday 17th February, 2017

- Depart Newark Liberty International Airport at 7:15 p.m. on United Airlines flight #120 to Barcelona El Prat de Llobregat International Airport

Day 2: Saturday 18th February, 2017

- Arrive in **Barcelona** at 9:00 a.m. where our full time bi-lingual Tour Manager meets the group to transfer by private motor coach to check in to a centrally located hotel for a 4 night stay
- Settle in to the hotel then depart at noon to tour the **Nou Camp Stadium**, home of *FC Barcelona* and the largest stadium in Europe, with a capacity of 120,000! Take in the immense stadium, pre-game chapel, pressrooms, tunnel and more
- From the Nou Camp depart for the fields of local club **Barcino FC** for **practice** with the PDA coaching staff from
- Dinner at a pre-selected restaurant after practice

Day 3: Sunday 19th February, 2017

- Breakfast at the hotel then enjoy a **guided walking tour of Barcelona** - due to its rich history, Barcelona is filled with landmark buildings and world-class museums, including the Museu Picasso, the Gothic cathedral, and La Rambla the multi-faceted tree-lined promenade cutting through the heart of Old Town
- Free time to further explore **Barcelona** - an enchanting seaside city with boundless culture, fabled architecture and great food!
- Dinner at a local restaurant at 6:00 p.m. then transfer to what is sure to be one of the highlights of the tour as you attend the **La Liga Professional Game** featuring **FC Barcelona** or **RCD Espanyol** (ticket included, game to be determined)
- Return to the hotel after the game

Day 4: Monday 20th February, 2017

- After breakfast transfer to **La Liga Professional Club RCD Espanyol** for **practice** with a *professional Spanish clinician*
- Return to the hotel to rest then transfer this afternoon to the **first friendly game** of the tour against a top local girl's youth club
- Dinner at a pre-selected restaurant after the game

Day 5: Tuesday 21st February, 2017

- Breakfast at the hotel then take the short trip north of the city to visit **Montserrat Mountain**, the most holy place in Catalonia where a Benedictine monastery sits on the side of a 4055 ft. high mountain of weird, bulbous peaks. The monastery was founded in 1025 after a statue of the Virgin Mary was found here, and pilgrims still come from all over Christendom to kiss the Black Virgin
- Return to **Barcelona** for lunch on your own then transfer to the tour's **second friendly game** against a top local girl's youth club
- Dinner at a pre-selected restaurant after the game

Day 6: Wednesday 22nd February, 2017

- Check out after breakfast and depart for the Spanish capital **Madrid**
- Pause en route to visit **Zaragoza** - this great city on the banks of the mighty Río Ebro has a people-friendly Spanish casco (old town) crammed with historic buildings and with a colorful traditional identity. Intriguing archaeology, fine art and architecture
- Continue to **Madrid** and **check in** to a centrally located hotel for a 4 night stay - Spain's capital is a wonderful city year-round, but you'll especially appreciate being here when the weather's warm and the kaleidoscopic variety of life Madrid-style courses through the streets or takes up residence in the city's plazas
- Dinner at a pre-selected restaurant this evening

Day 7: Thursday 23rd February, 2017

- Breakfast at the hotel then transfer to the *Ciudad Deportivo Real Madrid*, home of **La Liga Professional Club Real Madrid**, for a behind the scenes look at their facilities and then **practice** with a *professional Spanish clinician* from 12:30-2:00 p.m.
- Return to the hotel for lunch on your own and time to rest, before transferring to **La Liga Professional Club Rayo Vallecano** for the **third friendly game** of the tour
- Dinner at a pre-selected restaurant after the game

Day 8: Friday 24th February, 2017

- Breakfast at the hotel then depart to tour European soccer giants **Real Madrid's Bernabéu Stadium**, home Europe's most impressive trophy collection - stroll around the pitch, run through the tunnel and sit in the dressing room
- From the Bernabeu transfer to central **Madrid** for a free afternoon in the Spanish capital - The old and the new contrast vividly in Madrid, where narrow cobbled lanes and 17th-century chapels border modern boulevards and gleaming skyscrapers.
- Dinner at a pre-selected restaurant this evening

Day 9: Saturday 25th February, 2017

- After breakfast enjoy a **guided walking tour** of **Madrid** - Take in all the major sites including the Plaza Mayor, Almudena Cathedral and Puerta de Alcalà
- Free time after the game to complete your **Madrid** sightseeing and souvenir shopping
